Bakersfield- Clinica Sierra Vista is marking National Health Center Week 2013 with the Grand Opening/Open House of our newest health center, the Greenfield Community Health Center located at 9001 S. H Street, Bakersfield, CA 93307 on Thursday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> at 12 noon. This event will include a short program, a few dignitary remarks, a light lunch, and a tour of the new site. This event is part of a national campaign to raise understanding about the mission and accomplishments of America's Health Centers as local solutions for affordable and accessible health care.

The Greenfield Community Health Center is located at 9001 South H Street, Bakersfield, CA 93301 and expected to begin providing services on August 19, 2013. The new facility is 10,204 square feet, 10 exam rooms, fully equipped with an electronic health records system, and digital x-ray machine. The site will provide primary care services, including family practice, internal medicine, pediatrics, and obstetrics/gynecology. The center will offer health care for all life stages through the Primary Care Medical Home (PCMH) model, including age-appropriate immunizations, health screenings, and follow-up care for chronic diseases such asthma and diabetes.

The site will operate with extended hours of operation, open six (6) days a week at eleven (11) hours per day, totaling 66 hours per week, in order to accommodate patients who are unable to access care during a regular work week. This site will eventually staff 3.0 FTE medical providers and 16.0 FTE medical and support staff, including enabling staff for programs such as WIC, disease case management, insurance enrollment, integrated behavioral health, and comprehensive perinatal services. The location will serve 5,870 patients through approximately 17,000 medical patient visits.

In 2012, Clinica served 152,397 patients through 562,681 patient visits and has become the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest Federally Qualified Health Center in California and the nation.
